ORDINANCE NO. 2022-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SNOOK, TEXAS, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE CITY OF SNOOK, TEXAS, BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CITY FOR SUCH YEAR AS REFLECTED IN SAID BUDGET; AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND CONTAINING CERTAIN PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, within the time and in the manner required by law, the City Administrator of the City of Snook (the "City") has prepared and submitted to the City Council a budget estimate of expenditures and revenues of all City departments, divisions and offices for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022, and ending on September 30, 2023; and,

WHEREAS, such budget was timely filed with the City Secretary, has been available for inspection, was submitted to City Council, and a public hearing on such budget was held by City Council on August 22, 2022, after proper notice having been given in accordance with law; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the proposed budget and has made such changes therein as in its judgment were warranted by law and were in the best interest of the citizens and taxpayers of the City; and,

WHEREAS, a copy of such budget has been filed with the City Secretary and the City Council now desires to approve and adopt the same; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SNOOK:

<u>Section 1</u>. The facts and recitations set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

Section 2. The City Council hereby approves and adopts the budget described in the preamble of this Ordinance, a summary of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes and a copy of which is on file with the City Secretary. The City Secretary is hereby directed to place on said budget an endorsement, which shall be signed by the City Secretary, which shall read as follows: "The Official Budget of the City of Snook, Texas, for the Fiscal Year Beginning October 1, 2022, and Ending September 30, 2023." Such budget, as thus endorsed, shall be kept on file in the office of the City Secretary as a public record.

<u>Section 3</u>. In support of said budget and by virtue of the adoption thereof, the several amounts specified for the various purposes named in said budget are hereby appropriated to and for such purposes.
