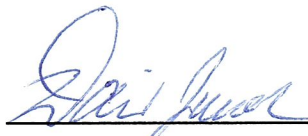

- I. Mayor Frank Fields called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.
- II. The pledges to the U.S. and Texas Flags were said.
- III. A quorum was established. Alderman Bradan Harris and Alderman Daniel Leschber were not in attendance.
- IV. Mayor Pro-Tem Tina Vega made a motion to adopt the agenda. Alderman Clarence Junek seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously 3-0.

- VI. **Action Items:**
 1. Mayor Frank Fields read the item and commented that the resolution would allow City staff to submit an application for \$500,000 to the Texas Water Development Board's Water Supply Infrastructure Grant. If awarded, the money would go towards the planning, acquisition, and design of a new groundwater well and related facilities. A motion was made to approve the filing of the application for the Texas Water Development Board's Water Supply and Infrastructure Grant and adopt the Authorized Representative Resolution, authorizing the designated representative to execute all required application documents on behalf of the City. A second was made by Alderman Brad Hays and carried unanimously 3-0.
