

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SNOOK, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2025-07; PROVIDING FOR REGULATIONS CONCERNING NOISE; REPEALER; SEVERABILITY; EFFECTIVE DATE; PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING.

WHEREAS, the City of Snook, Texas ("City") is a Type A General Law municipality incorporated and operating under the Laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51.001, the City Council of the City of Snook, Texas ("City Council") has the authority to adopt, publish, amend, or repeal an ordinance that is for the good government, peace, or order of the City and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is necessary and proper for the good government, peace, and order of the City of Snook to amend Section IX of Ordinance No. 2025-07;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SNOOK, TEXAS:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

That all of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council, and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if copied in their entirety.

II. AMENDMENTS

That Section IX of Ordinance No. 2025-07 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

IX. PERMIT

- (a) Any person engaging in construction operations, including, but not limited to demolition, repair, drilling, excavation, alteration, and concrete pouring may request a permit from the City Administrator before the construction operations begin. A permit granted under this Section creates an exemption to the requirements of this Ordinance. Construction operations producing sounds in excess of the dB(A) levels allowed by this Ordinance are unlawful if conducted without a permit.

- (b) Any person planning an event or gathering which the person expects will produce sounds in excess of the dB(A) levels allowed under this Ordinance may request a permit from the City Administrator prior to the event or gathering. A permit granted under this Section creates an exemption to the requirements of this Ordinance. Sounds produced at an event or gathering

that exceed the dB(A) levels allowed by this Ordinance are unlawful if produced without a permit.

(c) No fee will be charged for a permit under this Section.

III. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be and become effective immediately upon and after its passage and publication as may be required by governing law.

IV. REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in force when the provisions of this Ordinance become effective which are inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions contained in this Ordinance are hereby repealed only to the extent of such conflict.


V. SEVERABILITY

Should any part, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance be determined to be unlawful, void or unenforceable, the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be adversely affected. No portion of this Ordinance shall fail or become inoperative by reason of the invalidity of any other part. All provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

VI. PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING


It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was open to the public and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.
