MINUTES OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
August 10, 2026

The City Council of the City of Snook, Burleson County, Texas, convened in special meeting at the Snook City Hall on August 10, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. with Mayor Frank Fields presiding.

- I. Mayor Frank Fields called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.
- II. The pledges to the U.S. and Texas Flags were said.
- III. A quorum was established. Alderman Brad Hays was not in attendance.
- IV. Alderman Bradan Harris made a motion to adopt the agenda. Alderman Clarence Junek seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously 4-0.
- V. **Open Forum/Visitor's Comments:**

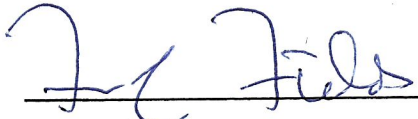

- VI. **Action Items:**
 1. Mayor Frank Fields read the item and City Administrator/City Secretary David Junek reviewed the tax rate calculation sheet provided by the Burleson County Tax Office with City Council. Alderman Clarence Junek asked what the current tax rate is and what is being proposed and Mr. Fields said the City is current at \$0.25/\$100 valuation and a \$0.28/\$100 valuation was being proposed and commented that the city had been at the current rate for a long time. Mr. Junek explained the impact of the tax increase as it related to the proposed budget and on certain property valuations. Mr. Fields commented that he was comfortable with the proposed \$0.28 tax rate and Mr. Junek agreed and compared it with the recent water/sewer utility rate increase by going up a little now versus going higher later. A motion was made by Alderman Bradan Harris to propose a tax rate of \$0.28 per \$100 valuation for FY 2027. A second was made by Alderman Clarence Junek and the following record vote was taken:

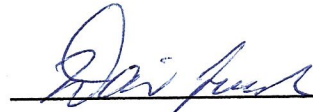
